The town of Lawrence was once the centre of one of The World's largest gold rushes, being the first gold rush town in Otago. It now bursts with boutique shops and quirky cafes, and an old fashion museum found right on the main street.

Lawrence is also where a local school teacher composed the music for New Zealand's national anthem in 1876. He is buried in the town's hilltop cemetery which is noted for its elaborate Victorian ironwork, Celtic crosses and Chinese section.

The Clutha Gold Cycle & Walking Trail starts/finishes in Lawrence, Otago. It is one of The Great Rides of New Zealand covering 73 kms, it is an easy grade trail and takes around 2-4 days to ride.

Not only does the town of Lawrence have so much to offer it is the gateway to Beautiful Central Otago, where summers are hot and filled with the beauty of local orchards and winter boasts ski fields full of perfect powdery snow.

Living in the South Otago region you have access to the wonderful coastal Catlins, a hidden gem. A place of natural beauty, abundant wildlife, forests and sandy beaches, waterfalls and both hilly and rolling green farmlands.
